POSITION: MEDICATION NURSING ASSISTANT DEPARTMENT OF LONG TERM CARE

Join our team as Medication Nursing Assistant (MNA) at Rockingham County Rehabilitation and Nursing Center. SCOPE OF POSITION:

The Medication Nursing Assistant is responsible for medication administration to stable residents; is directly responsible for performing specified services for residents as designated under the supervision of a licensed nurse; and provides medication administration as determined, delegated and monitored by a licensed nurse.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS:

- Consistently and independently follows established safety and Infection Control policies procedures
- Supports Resident Rights as defined in facility policies and procedures
- Actively participates in survey inspections made by authorized government agencies
- Participates in education and training events
- Assists with unit orientation for new employees, staff and agency personnel
- May be responsible for administration of topical, oral, nasal, ophthalmic, vaginal and rectal medications, inhalers; nebulizer treatments, o2 and documentation as directed by the licensed nurse.
- Replenishes medications and supplies as needed and maintains a clean and orderly medication cart and medication room.
- Effectively observes and communicates to the licensed nurse regarding administration and effectiveness of medication(s).
- Keeps licensed personnel informed of significant observations in resident care and environmental conditions, supply and equipment needs, and performance problems.
- Assists resident with all aspects of personal hygiene including: bathing, grooming, dressing, toileting, etc.
- Reports abnormalities in resident behavior or bodily function to the licensed nurse
- Records and reports intake and output when directed by the licensed nurse.
- Utilizes / follows established Infection Control measures at all times
- Complies with the established nursing standards, policies and procedures of the facility including resident confidentiality and privacy.

REQUIRED EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE:

- Successful completion of an approved course for Medication Nursing Assistant as set by the New Hampshire Board of Nursing and OBRA.
- Must possess a valid and current LNA license in New Hampshire
- Must possess a valid New Hampshire Medication Nursing Assistant license.
